



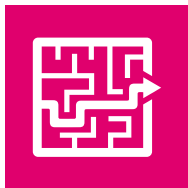

Our top five tips for getting the most out of this event - and making the best first impression

1. Ask questions:

You're here to see what your future placement or career options may be so think about some questions before you approach each stand. Try asking about their recruitment process, or the company culture. Avoid asking about salary – after all, it's the experience and opportunities you're looking for.

2. Sell yourself:

What can you offer companies? What have you learnt about yourself and your strengths during your degree and/or work experience? Tell them about your experiences and transferable skills. Show them that you're passionate about your future career – even if you're not quite sure what you want to do yet.

3. Check your etiquette:

A firm handshake, good eye contact and a positive attitude will help you be remembered.

4. Take notes:

You'll get lots of information from different companies so note down the name of the person you spoke to so you can reference them in your applications.
