inspiring the next generation of females into Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) via a series of impactful events and opportunities.

At the age of 20, she became one of the youngest people ever to be awarded a Master's in Mathematics & Computer Science by the University of Oxford, and her career has continued to soar.

In recognition of her significant influence and achievements, Anne-Marie was awarded an MBE in the 2017 New Year's Honours for services to young women and STEM sectors. In June of the same year, she was also made an Honorary Fellow at Keble College, Oxford.

2018 saw her listed among the top 50 women in the world in tech by Forbes, voted the 5th most influential woman in IT by Computer Weekly and recipient of the prestigious Barclays UK 'Woman of the Year' award.

In addition to her work championing getting women into STEM, Anne-Marie has amassed a wealth of experience through her work with Goldman Sachs. Hewlett-Packard. Deutsche Bank and Lehman Brothers. She is also a recognised thought leader in the tech space, regularly appearing as a media commentator, and giving talks at tech giants such as SXSW and Founders Forum.

Make the most of the Annual Careers Fair: 23 and 24 October



Do some research on the companies exhibiting at the fair - information can be found on MyCareerHub. You'll look much more professional and interested if you're knowledgeable about them, rather than having to ask 'so what do you do then?'

Take your CV

Bring along several copies of an upto-date CV to give out to employers. You're unlikely to gain a job offer on the day but you will meet people who can be very helpful in your first step to employment or a placement.

Dress to impress

There isn't a dress code for careers fairs, but as you're hoping to impress a potential future employer, it's good to dress smartly. Most of the representatives of the employers at the fair will be in business suits, so you'll fit in with them - it will also help you feel more professional and confident too.

Arrive early

Careers fairs can get very busy so if you arrive early you're more likely to find the employers' tables quieter and easier to approach, with more time to chat to their representatives. And visit both days!



Make sure that you talk to people; that's what they are there for!

And if you talk to someone who can offer you something in the future, leave your CV and make sure you take their card. Try to appear confident and interested, but without being arrogant. Judge the situation and use it as an opportunity to sell yourself if appropriate, but it is more likely you will be learning about the sorts of things their company does.

Stay focused!

Everyone loves freebies, but don't treat the fair as an opportunity to pick up as many free promotional items as possible you're there to research career possibilities so focus on the materials relevant for you.

Consider new opportunities

The great thing about careers fairs is that you can find out about companies and jobs that you may never have even considered before, so don't close your mind to new opportunities. You may find yourself a new dream job or placement!

Don't be shy!

Networking isn't easy, but try and be yourself - you will almost always be met with a friendly response so get stuck in. Be enthusiastic, demonstrate your interest, and focus on your talents and what the company has to offer. You will find the fair far more rewarding if you take this approach. The companies are there to meet you - they want to tell you about themselves too.

Follow up any leads

If you're given contact details from a company or sector you're interested in, make sure you make contact after the fair is over. You could simply thank them for their time and say how much you enjoyed meeting them. Or you could ask to be kept informed of future opportunities. If appropriate, you could even ask to meet with them to learn about the jobs they offer in more detail. Remember that they may have spoken to hundreds of people at the fair, so you have to stand out. The best way of doing this is to follow up the contact quickly and politely.
